Planning has begun for another Resume & Interviewing Workshop offered in partnership with the Paul Sawyier Library in Frankfort. The Career Center in Georgetown met with the New Opportunities School for Women to discuss ways in which WIA and NOSW can work together on job networking and employability skills for clients. A Workforce Specialist at the Career Center in Lexington has been selected to become a certified trainer provided by an initiative through the Childcare Council. The Career Center in Winchester is in plans to increase their presence in neighboring counties by offering Resume and Interviewing Skills Workshops in these counties.
